

Urlingford vs Coon Muckalee Roinn C Round 2

Urlingford NS produced a commanding display against Coon-Muckalee in Round Two of the Roinn C Hurling League, delivering a polished performance built on teamwork, energy, and clinical finishing.

Playing with the aid of the breeze in the opening half, Urlingford set the tone early. Pdraig Bourke opened the scoring with an excellent long-range point, quickly followed by another fine effort from David Maev. Will Bergin proved especially influential, contributing 1-2 in a lively first-half showing. Further substitutions saw players from 4th and 5th class introduced, and they made a real impact with their energy and enthusiasm—surely giving management plenty to consider for upcoming fixtures. Robbie Quinlan also impressed in defence, providing leadership and composure, particularly in guiding the younger players. Nial Rothwell and Alex Cashin were left with little work to do but looked very solid when called upon.

In the end, Urlingford ran out convincing winners on a scoreline of 3-12 to 0-0, a result that reflects their all-round strength and teamwork.
